



Class Selection Guide

These are the classes being offered for St. Edward Summer School 2010. Be sure to check the age and session availability of each. Not all classes are offered for all grades or in all sessions. **Some enrichment classes have an additional activity fee as indicated in their description.** When choosing an age group, please use the grade that the student will be entering in the fall of 2010. **Students referred by teacher or principal must attend both Sessions 1 and 3.**

Arts & Crafts Grades 1-2, Grades 3-8, Session 1 and 2. Students will experiment with various art media and materials to create individualized projects. **Enrichment**
There is an additional \$8.00 activity fee required.

Beginning Writing Gr. 2-4, Session 2 only. Do you ever wish you could write your own story? Do you want to learn more about the writing process? Do you want to become a better writer? This class offers opportunities to learn about the writing process, practice writing, and making a shape book. All types of writers are encouraged to take this class. **Remedial and Enrichment**

Brain Booster Games! Grade 4-6, Session 2 only. Strengthen a different part of your brain, and have fun doing this! Learn and practice games of skill that you can play individually like Sudoku and Tangrams or with a buddy like backgammon, checkers, chess and more.
Enrichment

Chemistry Concoctions Grades 4-8 Session 2 only. An exploration of some cool chemistry concoctions that will get you excited about the subject of chemistry. Additional **\$5.00 activity fee required.** **Enrichment**

Computers Grades 1-3, Session 1. Computers & Online Safety Tips for Kids
Students will be given an introduction to basic computer skills (typing, color drawing, and color printing). Additionally, students will have an opportunity to learn about internet browsing, effective image searching, on-line games, and online safety tips. **Enrichment**

Computers Grades 4-5, Session 1. Clip-art 4 Kids
Students will use clipart to create cartoons, drawings and their own stories. They will use Power Point to create their animations. The emphasis is on the use of clipart and animations. **Lots of Fun!!!** There is an additional **\$5.00 fee required** to cover the cost of CD's.

Computers Grade 6-8, Session 1 only. Creating My Own Movie – Movie Maker
Students will cover video editing of digital content (still-images and audio files). Student will apply special effects and transition to their digital content. The final edited work (a movie) will be imported to Windows Movie Maker. **Enrichment.** There is an additional **\$5.00 fee required** to cover the cost of CD's.

Cooking Grades 1-8, Sessions 1 and 3. Come and explore your culinary talents and skills in cooking and baking! An additional **\$10.00 activity fee is required to cover food. Enrichment**

Creative Writing Grades 5-8, Session 3 only. Students will have the opportunity to use their imaginations. We will read and enjoy shorter works, noting the techniques of published writers. Emphasis will be placed on writing as a process: effective brainstorming, prewriting, editing, and revision. Students and teacher will talk about each piece of writing, discussing strengths and weaknesses. Instruction will be provided to boost skills. Three to four pieces will be written, and one will be revised and put into final form. Students will be asked to share this piece with the class. **Remedial and Enrichment**

Emerging Artists! Gr. 1-2, Session 2 only. Welcome young artists to a week of fun art projects using a variety of different media that are unique and cool to use for the emerging artist! **\$8.00 activity fee required. Enrichment**

Enlightened Engineers Gr. 5-8, Session 1 only. Learn and test out your engineering skills by working in teams to create fun and practical mini-engineering projects! With an engineering goal, a team, a reasonable “budget” and “Mrs. Tang’s Enlightened Engineers Store” to shop at for every project, you’re bound to be thinking and working like an engineer! There is an additional **\$8.00 activity fee required** for materials, tools, team photos, and prizes

English Review Grades 5-8, Session 2 only. Tired of all those red marks on your written assignments? Here is the class for you! We will review elements of grammar, usage, and mechanics that young writers must master in order to be proficient. Students will be challenged to daily exercises in editing. Skills mastered will be applied to writing. We will practice writing sentences of varied structure and paragraphs that are organized and well developed. **Remedial**

Fiction: Short Stories Grades 5-8, Session 1 and 2. Students will read and write short stories. The work of numerous authors will be shared. Works will be discussed and critically analyzed. Class will culminate with dramatic readings of work produced. Skills targeted are critical reading and analysis, writing as a process, illustration, and dramatic reading. **Remedial and Enrichment**

Geography Galore! Grades 1-3 Session 2 only. A whirlwind tour of Planet Earth one continent at a time to get excited and fascinated with geography. **Enrichment**

Grammar Skills Grades 1-2, Session 1, Grades 1-3, Session 2. This class will be an introduction to nouns, verbs, adjectives, etc. as well as the proper use of punctuation and capitalization. **Remedial and Enrichment**

Grammar Skills Grades 3-5, Session 2 only. This class will be a review of proper use of speech, punctuation, capitalization, fragment/complete sentences, and proper verb use. **Remedial**

Language Arts Grades 3-8, Session 1 only. This class will focus on both reading and writing components during the two weeks. Students will read and interpret short stories, identify aspects of writing and create pieces of their own. **Enrichment and Remedial**

Literature Grade 6-8, Session 3 only. This class involves reading different forms of Literature. Students will learn to identify different parts of a piece of writing while enjoying and interpreting the meaning of the work. **Remedial/Enrichment**

Math Grades 1-2, All Sessions. Students will learn to improve problem solving techniques through manipulative and cooperative learning strategies. Emphasis will be on addition, subtraction, patterns, measurement, time, and money. **Remedial**

Math Grades 3-4, Session 1 only, Grades 3-5, All Sessions. This class will review addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions, word problems, time, and money. **Remedial**

Math Grades 4-5 Session 3 only. This class will review addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions, word problems, time, and money. **Remedial**

Math Grades 5-8, Session 1&3. This class offers students the opportunity to strengthen and reinforce basic math fundamentals. Focus areas will include mastery of decimals, fractions, ratios, and their application. Students in grades 7-8 will also have an emphasis on Pre-Algebra skills and word problem solving. **Remedial**

Math Review Grades 5-8, Session 2 only. This class will provide students with basic math skills each day. **Remedial**

Money/Time Gr. 1-3, Session 1 and 3. The focus on this class will be giving the students the opportunity to work hands-on with money, making change, identifying coins, understanding the elements of time, and elapsed time using Judy clocks. **Enrichment**

Music Grades 1-6, Session 2 only. If you were born to make music then this is the class for you. Students will experience the love of music in a variety of ways: singing, dancing, playing instruments, and will learn some sign language to accompany some of the songs. **Enrichment**

Our Fifty States Grades 3-5, Session 3 only. This class will give students an opportunity to become more familiar with our 50 states and their capitals. They will also learn about important historical events and various American heroes whose efforts have helped shape our nation. This won't be a boring lecture class, but an interactive, cooperative, hands-on class. **Remedial and Enrichment**

Pre-Algebra Grades 5-8, Session 2 Only, Gr. 6-8 Session 1 and 3. This class provides an introduction to the basics of algebra, which would benefit both students in regular and advanced mathematics courses. Manipulatives will be used to increase understanding of concepts. Students will practice basic computation and problem solving. **Remedial and Enrichment**

Rainforest Grades 1-3, Session 3 only. Students will discover the ways of the Rainforest through research, reading and art activities. **Enrichment**

Reading Grades 1-2, Sessions 1 & 3. This class offers students a chance to improve their reading and writing skills. The focus will be on recognizing sounds and letters in context, blending sounds into words, recognizing parts of speech within reading material. **Remedial**

Reading Grades 2-3, Session 2 only, Grades 4-6 Session 3 only. Increase reading comprehension and writing skills! Students will focus on reading fluency, vocabulary enrichment, and enjoy interesting imagery in a variety of reading adventures! **Remedial**

Rhythms-n-Beats---Stomp! Grades 5-8, Session 3 only. Students will learn and apply rhythms to learn dance moves traditionally called “stomp” or “step dance”. A fun filled and high-energy class that will get you energized about learning rhythms and putting those rhythms into action! **Enrichment**

Study Skills Grades 4-6, Session 3 only. As students move into the upper grades, it becomes even more critical that they have the study skills to handle the workload. This class will teach the basics needed to be successful: setting goals, organization, time-management, note taking, reading habits and speed, critical dictionary skills, test-taking, and vocabulary in context. Students will keep a record of all information shared and will have this in place the next academic year. **Enrichment**

Vacation Bible Grades 1-3, Session 3 only. This class will provide students with an interesting and enjoyable way to learn more God, Jesus, and other interesting Bible characters. With the help of church videos, art projects, and fun games, students will study some of their favorite Bible stories. **Enrichment**

Vocabulary Building Grades 4-6 Session 1 only, Grades 5-8, Session 3. The 26 letters of the alphabet will never look the same again! Build your own word knowledge by engaging in some classic and some new word games while also practicing spelling, word origins, and strategy. **Remedial and Enrichment**

Writing Workshop Grades 3-5, Session 1 only, Grades 5-8, Session 1& 2. This class is meant to be a creative adventure! Students will read examples of good writing by professional authors and use these as models for their own writing. Basic writing skills will be practiced and there will also be opportunities to design and illustrate books for their favorite pieces of writing. **Remedial and Enrichment**
